The first thing that I picked out was 'Total Assets Under Management in the UK' stands at £7.7 trillion, second only to the US.

In terms of client types, pension funds total £2.6 trillion of that £7.7 trillion.

And, on a similar theme, institutional clients (which includes pension funds and insurance companies), is around 80% of the total investment in the UK.
